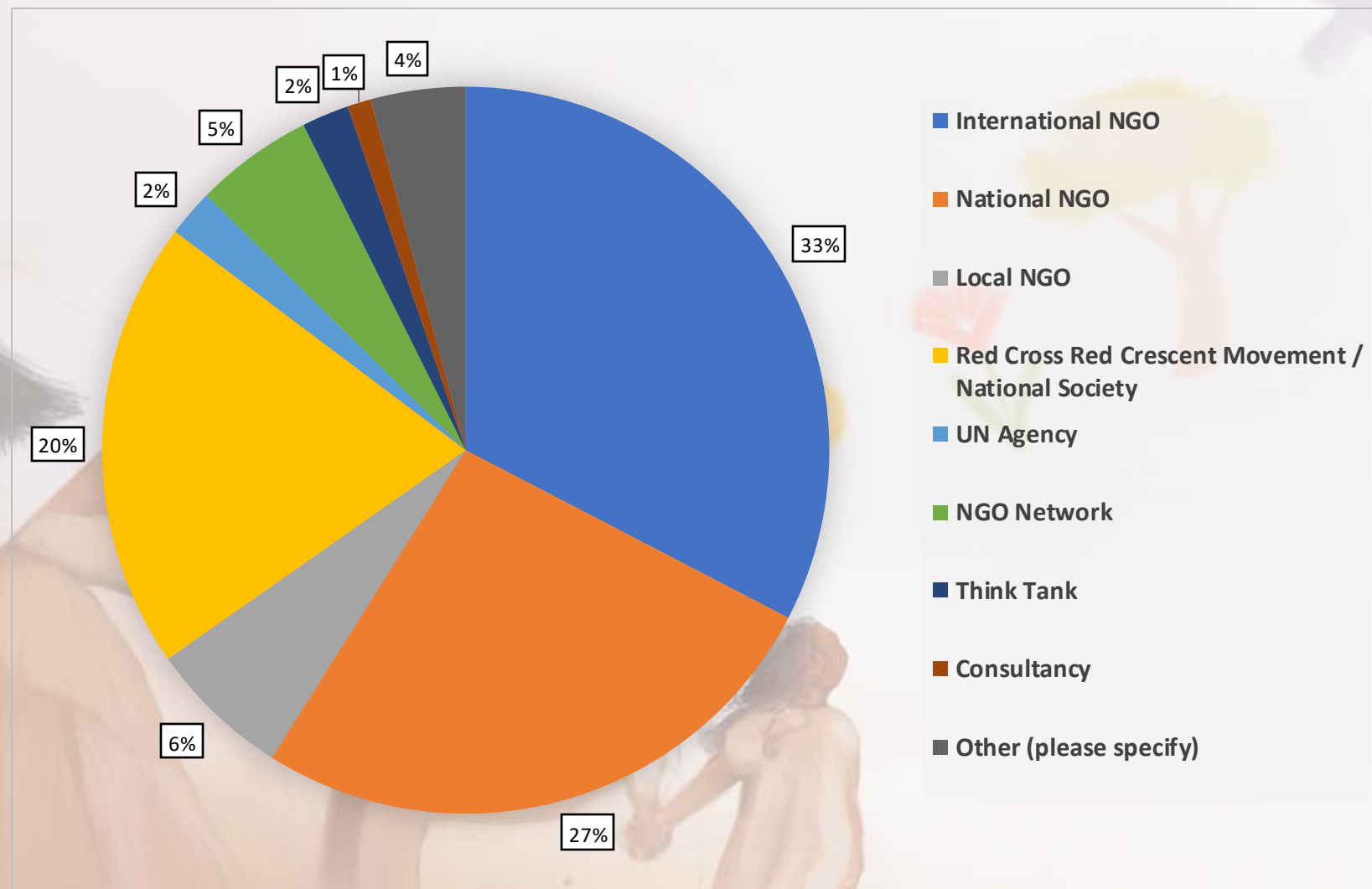

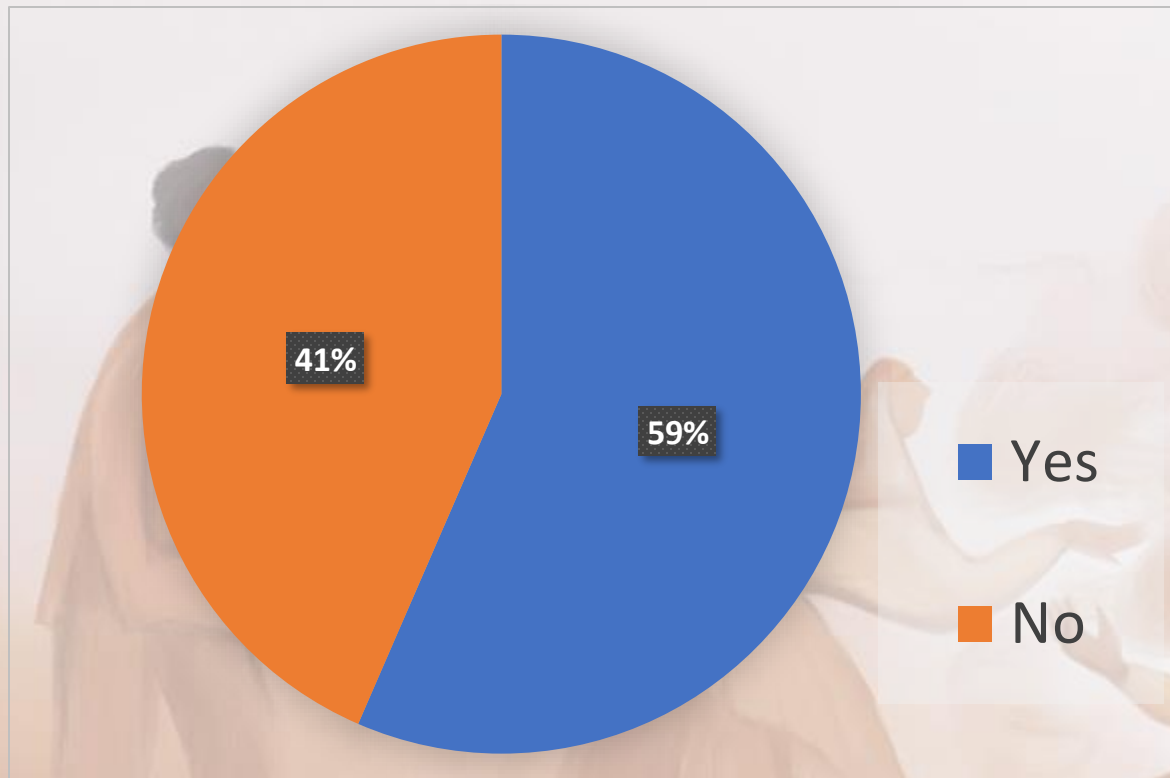

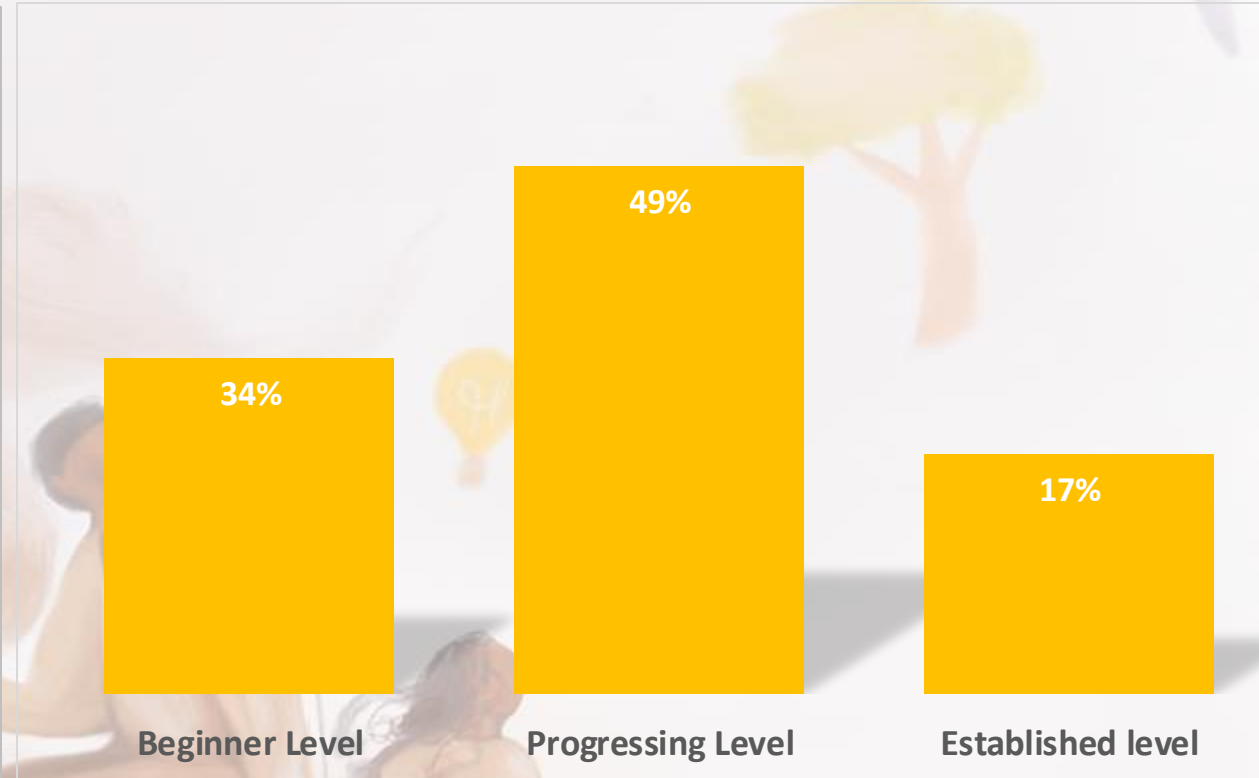

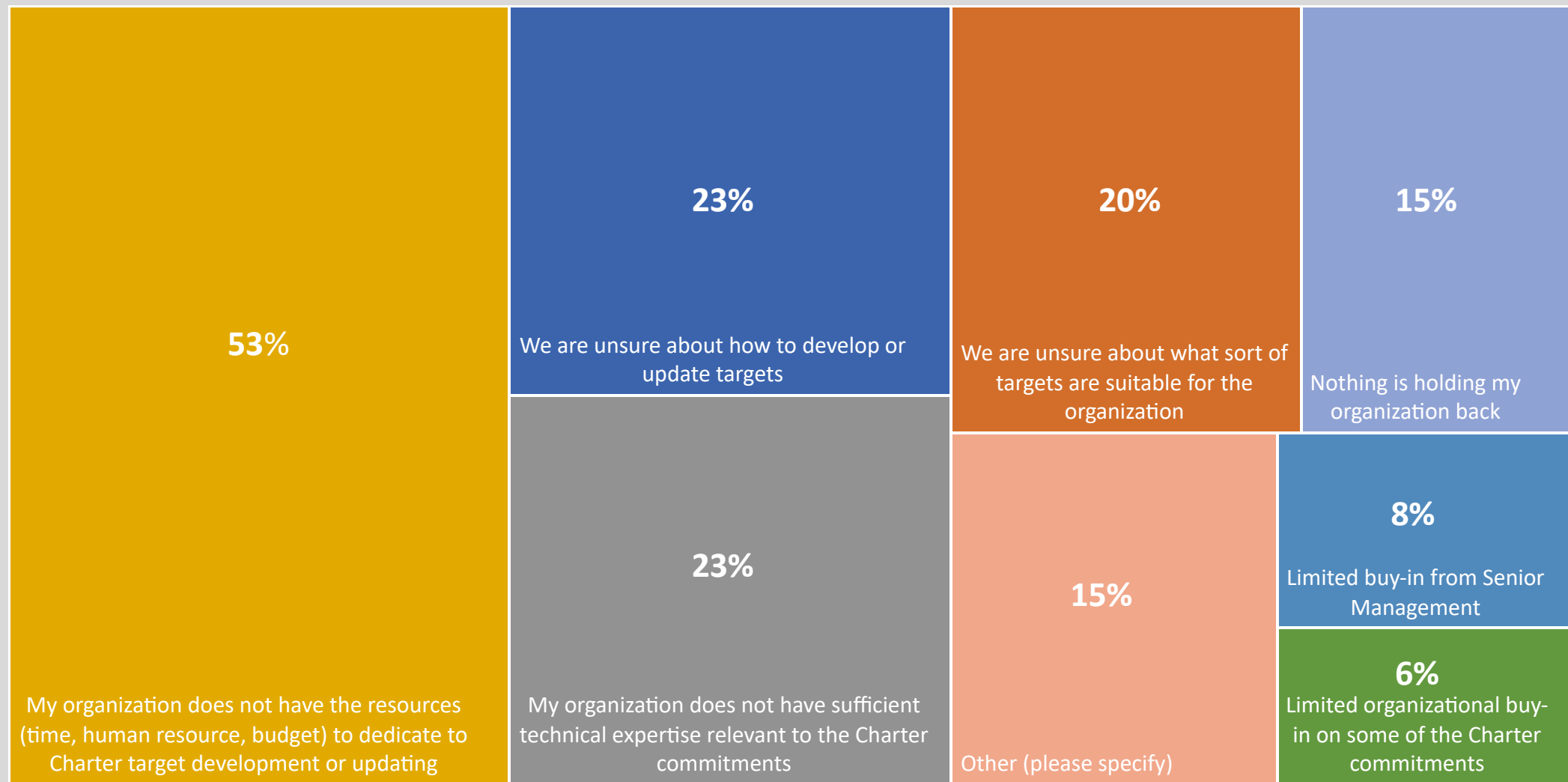
Are you aware of guidance available on the Charter Website?



How would you rate your organization's ability (knowledge and skills) to implement the Charter's commitments?

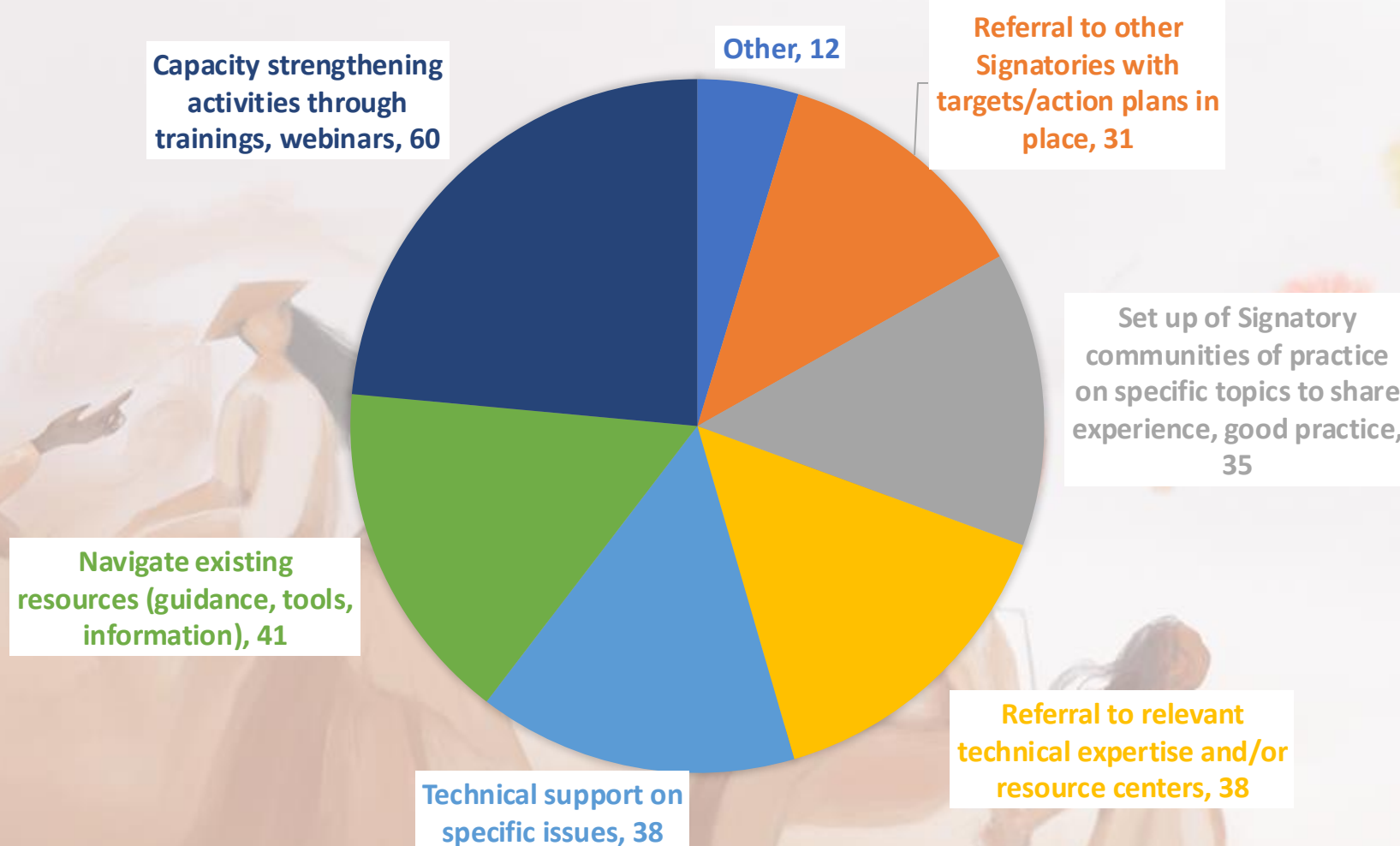


# Challenges faced by organizations from developing and updating targets



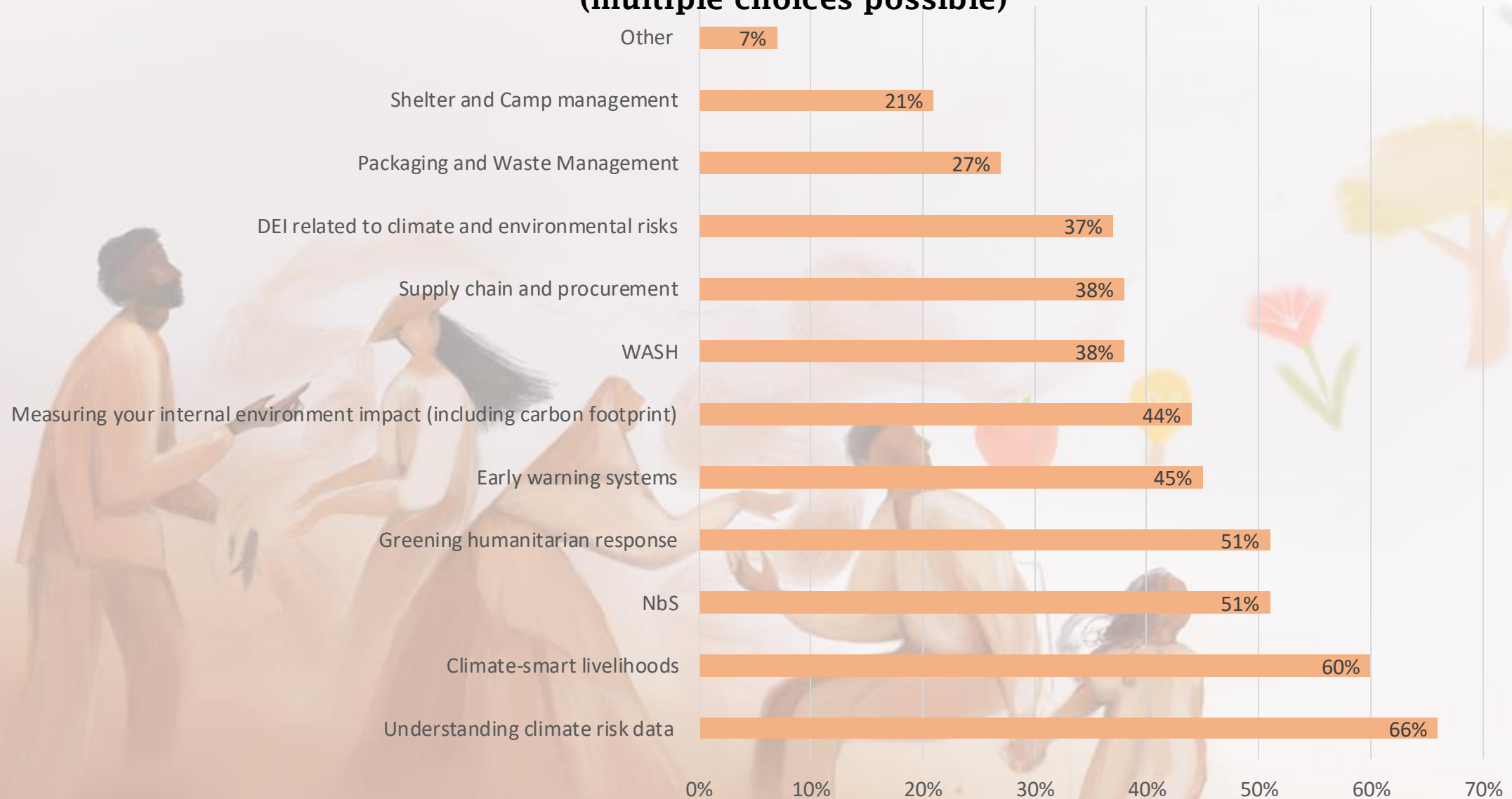
